Lifecom Completes Phase 1 Clinical Trial With OHSU

PORTLAND, Ore. May 9, 2007. - Lifecom Inc. is pleased to announce that Phase 1 Clinical Trial of its artificial intelligence and graphical medical record system has been completed. The trial was conducted at a primary care clinic associated with Oregon Health & Science University (OHSU).

Patients with a defined range of chief complaints were evaluated by a medical assistant who had been given only two hours of training. The Lifecom System accepts any data in any order, and presents questions based on the input data and its knowledge repository to refine the diagnosis. Patients were then diagnosed by a physician who did not have access to the Lifecom System diagnostic results or questions.

The diagnosis considered most likely by the Lifecom System agreed with the physician's diagnosis in 91 percent of the cases. In 8 percent of the cases, the physician's diagnosis was listed in the Lifecom System list of possibilities. One case is under review. "We have achieved more than we had hoped for in the first trial and are now actively preparing for a more advanced trial to expand the patient population that can be cared for by a single physician with an appropriate support staff and advanced technology," said Peter Kohler, M.D., OHSU president emeritus and CHAMP Project leader. The purpose of the CHAMP Project is to utilize technology to improve the efficiency and efficacy of primary care.

"These results are very promising, and I think they lend strong support to the direction we have taken with our technology and interface designs," said Stephen Datena, M.D., Lifecom's founder and chief medical officer.
